- Professional Services Organizations (PSOs) offer their clients customized, knowledge-based services and expertise.
- PSO businesses include IT consultants, media and advertising companies, healthcare consultants, and accounting and engineering firms, as well as smaller shops with several consultants serving niche clientele.
- Despite the pandemic, 2021 saw the greatest PSO market growth in a decade. That success is largely due to two factors: PSOs sell expertise, not products, so they're relatively immune to supply chain disruptions. And, these companies were already moving to provide more remote and virtual consulting.
- During 2021, PSOs topped 73% billable utilization and posted nearly 16% net profit.
